RACE TRACK ADDENDUM

THE RULES WITHIN ARE THE GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ALL INEX LEGEND CARS THAT COMPETE IN THE 2025 SEASON.

THE MOST RECENT INEX SANCTIONED RULE BOOK WILL BE ENFORCED.

ADDITIONAL RULES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE DUE TO SAFETY CONCERNS, OVERLY COMPETITIVE CARS, OR FUTURE RULES IMPOSED BY THE NJ STATE POLICE.

FIRE SUPPRESSION SYSTEM

The installation of a 5 pound fire suppression system is now required in all Sportsman race cars. EFFECTIVE DATE: AUGUST 1, 2023.

- It must at least be manual, can be upgraded to automatic.
- o 1 nozzle required. Must be pointed into the cockpit (driver.)
- SFI Certification required.
- The bottle date must always be within 2 years of the current date.
 Recertification cost approx. \$25 plus shipping.
- Bottle(s) must always be full and charged.
- Visitors and drivers "new" to Wall Stadium (first race of the season) will be granted a 1-2 race waiver. Turkey Derby is excluded.

FIRE SUPPRESSION SYSTEM

The installation of a 5 pound fire suppression system is now required in all Sportsman race cars. EFFECTIVE DATE: AUGUST 1, 2023.

- o It must at least be manual, can be upgraded to automatic.
- 1 nozzle required. Must be pointed into the cockpit (driver.)
- SFI Certification required.
- The bottle date must always be within 2 years of the current date.
 Recertification cost approx. \$25 plus shipping.
- Bottle(s) must always be full and charged.
- Visitors and drivers "new" to Wall Stadium will be granted a 1-2 race waiver. If races are not consecutive week-to-week, additional waivers will be granted.

Turkey Derby is excluded from this requirement.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- The use of a HANS DEVICE or Hans-like device is MANDATORY. 5 year expiration.
- 5-point Harness MANDATORY. SFI 38.1 Belts good for 2 years.
- Full face Helmets are MANDATORY. Must have Snell SA 15 or newer sticker.
- <u>Driver must wear a one piece fire suit</u> and flame retardant underwear. Both must be in good condition, no rips or holes! SFI 5
- Fire retardant gloves and driving shoes required. Fire retardant socks suggested.
- Full containment seat MANDATORY.
- New Jersey resident racers required to have a fire suppression system (see page 1.)

The age for participation is 17 with a valid Driver's License.

Minors with racing experience (without a driver's license) may be able to compete if special permission is granted by the NJ State Police through Wall Stadium Speedway management.

Parent or Guardian: Email the minor's racing resume (list all racing experience, including year, race track and finishes) and a clear photo or scan of the minor's Birth Certificate along with a note granting the minor permission to race at Wall Stadium Speedway to

This process may take up to 6 weeks.

- Up to date INEX license card required. License card must be presented at the Pit Trailer or be on file (Main Office) with the track in order to compete. A Wall Stadium Speedway Pit License will be required for any driver who will race more than 3 times this season.
- All rules enforced per 2025 INEX Rulebook plus amendments or revisions.
- As per INEX recommendation, the track will mandate all competitors to use the same gasoline source. This will be Premium gas from a Wawa gas station. You must be able to present your receipt to compete. Random gas samples will be taken frequently.
- Arm restraints required.
- Jersey Kits installed per INEX / NJ Rules. Exceptions may be granted for special events or limited appearances. Waived for Turkey Derby.
- See Handicap rules.
- Track reserves the right in determining Rookie status and qualifications of all competitors.
